1. At its 53rd meeting, on 16 December 1991, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/46/60) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Second Committee in its report (A/46/737, para. 10). The Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions presented the Committee's report orally.

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

2. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution 1/ an additional appropriation of \$368,600 would be required under section 1 (Overall policy-making, direction and coordination) of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1992-1993. Such requirements would constitute an additional expenditure derived from legislative mandates not provided for in the proposed programme budget for 1992-1993 and would therefore be subject to the

guidelines for the use of the contingency fund approved by the General Assembly in its resolution 42/211 of 21 December 1987. In addition, an additional appropriation of \$56,000 would be required under section 36 (Staff assessment), offset by the same amount under income section 1 (Income from staff assessment).
